PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

2" x 6" x 9" (50.8mm x 152.4mm x 228.6mm) Firestop Pillows are one-part, self-supporting, ready-to-use intumescent firestop material encased in a polyethylene 'pillow-like' bag. They are designed for use in firestopping large voids and openings made for penetrating items such as cables, cable trays, ductwork, pipes, and conduits in fire-rated floor or wall assemblies. Firestop pillows are intended for wall and/or floor openings through fire separations where temporary or permanent firestops are required.

In fire conditions, the intumescent material within each pillow dramatically expands to seal the opening from fire, maintaining the integrity of the fire separation and preventing the flow of fire, smoke, and gases.

- Large, open voids that may contain cables, cable trays, pipes, conduits, or nothing at all.

- To be used only in the tested configurations or as recommended by Everkem Diversified Products.

- Pillows are not structural, and are not designed to support the penetrating items they protect, nor can they support traffic.

INSTALLATION

SURFACE PREPARATION

APPLICATION

Surfaces should be clean of any debris or material that may prevent or deter proper contact of installation of fire-rated putty pads.

- 1. Estimate the number of bags required by:
 - A. Calculate the size in square inches of the openings to be firestopped.
 - B. Calculate the area in square inches required by the penetrating items.
 - C. Subtract [B] from [A] and divide by the coverage shown in the below chart

30% Compression	20% Compression
18.9 sq. in (121.9 sq. cm)	21.6 sq. in. (139.35 sq. cm)

- 2. If wire mesh will be used the pillows must be installed by being compressed to a minimum of 20%. If no wire mesh will be used the pillows must be compressed to a minimum of 30%
- 3. When installing, avoid protrusions and sharp corners so as not to damage the bags.
- 4. See UL tested diagrams for further proper application and installation procedures.

CLEANUP

Remove any debris from the installation area. Store between 0°F and 150°F under protective cover.
